When you get to the conference room, **press X** to enter the Zoom session. Please make sure that your camera and microphones are turned off.

At the end of the session, when you return to the conference room on Gather.Town, make sure that you closed all your Zoom tabs in order to re-activate your microphone and camera.



For oral presenters, please have your presentation ready at least 5 min before your turn. You can turn on your microphone and camera when the chair invites you to do so. You can then start sharing your screen. We recommend you to share your whole screen as opposed to the application (PowerPoint, PDF, etc.), and make sure to set your presentation to full-screen.

You can start presenting as soon as your presentation is visible to everyone.

Please respect the time allocated to your contribution. The chair will signal you 1 min before the end of your presentation with this: 🙋

After the questions, please turn off your microphone and camera. You are more than welcome to continue discussing your work in Gather.Town. Many private and public areas have been set up for this purpose, including rooms with whiteboards.

For attendees, we invite you to submit your question during the talk via the chat. The chair will ask them on your behalf in chronological order. You can nonetheless request to speak if you wish to ask a question directly or react to the discussion. To do so, click on the reaction tab and raise your hand 🙋 . Please turn off your microphone afterward.
